The article titled "Use of U-500 Insulin in the Treatment of Severe Insulin Resistance," by Cochran and Gorden (*Insulin*. 2008;3:211–218), contained an error. In the Background section of the Abstract, sentences 2 and 3 should read: "This is particularly problematic in patients with severe insulin resistance, defined as insulin requirement >200 units/day (>3 units/kg per day for pediatric patients). It is difficult to use U-100 forms of insulin at doses >200 units/day because of the volume of insulin being administered subcutaneously."
